

ENGAGE CONFERENCE RULES & GUIDELINES

Attendance - All youth and adult sponsors are expected to attend all sessions, applicable service projects, and other conference-related events (unless stated as optional).

Conduct - Be kind to those people around you. Refrain from swearing, fighting, stealing, ill-behavior. Take care of the host site's property; no vandalism, climbing trees or structures, no entering buildings other than those used during the course of the Conference.

Fighting/Bullying - Fighting and/or bullying (physical or verbal) is strictly prohibited. Any fighting, including pushing, shoving, tripping, spitting, punching, kicking, etc. is subject to the possible immediate removal from the Conference. All cost incurred because of being sent home, are the responsibility of your parent/guardian(s) and/or church.

"Water-fighting" or practical jokes - using water or any other liquid/gel/foam substance in host site buildings or outdoors is prohibited.

Opposite Sex Relationships - Treat each other with respect and remember to "leave room for Jesus." Guys are not permitted on the female dorm floors and ladies are not permitted on male dorm floors. No one is allowed to be on the dorm floors where none of the Conference participants are staying. Failure to abide by this rule may result in the immediate removal from the Conference. All cost incurred because of being sent home, are the responsibility of your parent/guardian(s) and/or church.

Leaving Property - Youth are not permitted to leave campus at any time, unless granted permission from their advisor, or during scheduled Conference activities. **THIS IS FOR YOUR SAFETY!**

Cell Phones - Please silence or turn off your phone while in sessions and planned meeting times. If allowed by your advisor, phones may be used during free times.

Drugs, Tobacco products, Vape products, Alcohol & Weapons - Are not permitted at Engage Conference. Persons found with any of these items may be sent home. All cost incurred because of being sent home, are the responsibility of your parent/guardian(s) or church.

Quiet Hours - Are from 12:00 am till 6:00 am, daily. You must stay inside your rooms during this time. **IT IS FOR YOUR SAFETY!**

Dress Code - The less skin showing the better. This means no shirts that show your stomach or pants that show your backside. Skirts and shorts must be fingertip length. Tops must have two-inch straps. No spaghetti strap tops, bikinis, or Speedos. If you should choose to wear a tankini, be sure that it completely covers your torso.

Name Tags - Yes, you need to wear it. This is your admission ticket to all worship services and events during the week. If you lose your name tag, please stop by the Engage Conference HQ before or after a worship service and we'll get you a new one.

Conduct in Auditorium - Glow sticks are also not allowed in the Auditorium. Also no standing on chairs, or entering the stage (unless instructed to do so).

Rooms - The room you choose/or assigned is yours for the week. Do not swap rooms with another person; move beds or furniture from one room to another. Also, keep your room clean and free of damages. If you notice any damage done to your room when you move in, tell your advisor at that time. If the host site charges us for extra cleaning or repairs for damages, you'll be sent the bill. In addition, do not move/rearrange Lobby furniture.

Linens – For an additional cost, you can receive linens during Conference. But you must indicate that at the time you register on-line.

Adult Sponsors - Your Adult Sponsor is your go-to-person for the week. Check in with them at night before going to bed if you have problems, questions, concerns, or worries. If you don't know who your Adult Sponsor is, please check at the Engage Conference HQ.

Medical Needs - If you need assistance, see your Adult Sponsor.

Extra Money - There will be opportunities throughout the week of Engage where you may have need of extra spending money. These situations include, but are not limited to: ordering a late night pizza, coffee shop, vending/concessions, campus bookstore, etc.

Check Out - You may check out of your dorm by doing the following...

1. Clean up your room; throw away all garbage in a proper receptacle. Make sure the room looks like it did when you moved in at the start of the week.
2. Return your key card to your adult sponsor (who will turn them in all together at a designated area).
3. Any participant not checked out by FRIDAY 10 AM will be charged for an additional night of housing (\$99.00).
