It's my first time at Engage Conference. What can I expect?

We design conference to be highly hands-on and diverse. What is the cost of conference? Is there a deposit due?

The rate is as follows: \$129 for both students and advisors

*Payment in full must be made by the start of Conference and can be completed during the Registration process.

And yes, a deposit of \$50 per person is required when you register online.

Can I register a student after the final deadline of June 30th, 2020?

No. Registrations will be closed June 30, 2021. We have to provide the convention center our final numbers July 1, thus the need for a firm deadline.

Where do I register when I arrive?

Everyone will check in at Engage Conference HQ, at the John S. Knight Center. Follow the signs. When you arrive, be sure to have any potential waivers / advisor background checks ready to turn in.

Is there a packing list?

Is there a nurse on staff?

Yes, the John S. Knight Center provides a certified medical person, who will be onsite during the event. Outside of the John S. Knight Center, you'll be responsible for all medical needs for your group.
